BELAMET UK LTD WASTE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING POLICY

General Statement

It is Bellamet UK's policy to ensure a high level of commitment to good environmental policies and processes throughout our business. It is our intention to develop this policy by minimising the production of waste, through good purchasing practice, efficient use of materials through production, minimizing rejects and promoting the reuse & recycling of materials and packaging.

To help ensure we give proper consideration to our environmental & waste management responsibilities and to assist in the minimisation of waste & the recycling of materials, wherever practical systems and procedures will be implemented to encourage the reusing and recycling of material with a view to minimizing the overall levels of waste.

All staff are expected to abide by the following procedures and co-operate with management in the execution of this policy.

Specific Aims

- A work culture with a high level of awareness of waste management, waste minimisation and a desire to reuse and recycle materials where practical.
- Use ISO14001 as a core to Bellamet UK's management.
- Promote economy in the use of materials generally and in particular sheet steel and packaging.
- Encourage the re-use of packaging materials. All card board and paper packaging is either reused internally for distribution or sent to a local recycling facility.
- Minimise waste by assisting suppliers in re-using/exchanging specific packaging and material handling by returning reusable packaging back to them.
- Wherever possible local suppliers are used to ensure the shortest logistical paths
- Encourage employees to promote and establish recycling schemes that are relevant to their individual activities.
- Monitor and measure waste where ever possible.
- Use safe and proper methods and suppliers to dispose of waste
- Store Electrical waste safely and dispose of in an efficient and ethical process using suitable supplier.

Future Aims

We are committed to continually improving and expanding our reusing & recycling processes and procedures for recycling other wastes in the future.
